Medicine Policy

We are happy to give your child non-prescribed medication if you have signed a parental permission form for us to do so.

If your child needs to take medication prescribed by a doctor, please discuss this with us. We will need you to sign an additional permission form. In some cases a child on antibiotics may be asked not to attend for 2-3 days in case they react to the medication and to prevent the spread of an infection to others.

It is vital that you inform us of any medication you may have given your child before they arrive into our care. We need to know what medicine they have had, the dose and time given.

All medicine given to us to administer must be in its original bottle/container and not decanted. It must have the manufacturers guidelines on it and if it is a prescription medication the details from the doctor or pharmacy.

We will ensure that all medication given to us is stored correctly and we will check that it is still within its expiry date.

If your child has a self-held medication please obtain an additional one to be kept on the premises. If your child has acute allergies and needs an epipen, please discuss this with us. We may need additional training to administer some forms of medication.

We will record all medication administered and will request a parental signature at the end of each day.

If you have any concerns regarding medication please do not hesitate to discuss them with us.
